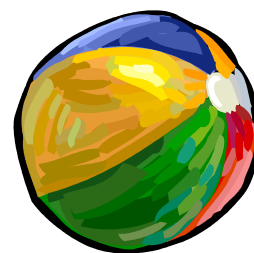
- **December 12th - Trinity Care Center in Farmington | 1:30-3:30pm**
