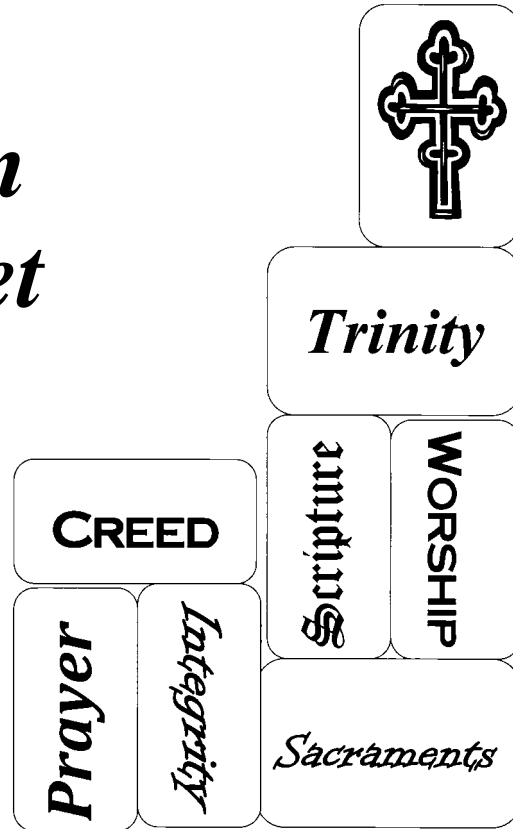

Confirmation Checklist 2011/2012

Confirmation Evenings of Reflection—all required.

These candidate/adult partner gatherings will focus on the Sacrament of Confirmation, what it means, and how we live it out. Students all attend **Sunday** May 14th, no Monday option.

- “Confirmed as Disciples”: Sunday January 8/ Monday January 9
- “Gifted in the Spirit”: Sunday April 15/ Monday April 16
- “Go Forth & Bear Witness” (ALL) Sunday May 14 (7:00—8:30 PM)

Mass Attendance

Student preparing for Confirmation are expected to attend Mass every Sunday. During final preparation (January –April) attendance will be tracked through the student journal.

Individual Parish Involvement

Requirement for Confirmation is two events throughout the year. You are asked to participate in one project for each area (Learning and Service). Many requirements can be met though Youth Ministry, FEP, or CHS. Students will reflect on these in their journal.

Learning Event

Any parish event that has its focus on learning about your faith. Examples: Parish Advent Retreat, Youth Group, Bible Study, Advent Family Night, Adult Formation evenings. This requirement is separate from the retreat requirement.

Service Event

Any activity that serves the parish, the community or people in need. The preference is for students to connect with the parish for this service. Examples: Armful of Love, being server, usher or musician, Super Saturday Service (FEP & CHS service projects “count”).

Sponsor Connections

Confirmation Reflection Days/Evenings

You and a sponsor (or a parent) are expected to attend three Confirmation Reflection events during the coming year. Students *must* have sponsor (or parent) with them at each gathering.

“Confirmed as Disciples”: This 2-hour event is required for all preparing for Confirmation. It is intended to help candidates and their partners better understand the Sacrament of Confirmation and together begin the formal preparation process. At this session candidates will receive and begin their Confirmation Journal.

- Dates and times correspond with the January FEP Schedule.

“Gifted in the Spirit”: This 2-hour event is required for all who are preparing for the Sacrament. The focus of this gathering will be on the power of the Holy Spirit to change and renew our lives. At this gathering candidates will return their completed journals.

- Dates and times correspond with the April FEP Schedule.

“Go Forth and Bear Witness”: This candidate/sponsor evening is the conclusion of preparation. It is a time to celebrate our faith and to prepare for Confirmation on May 20th. This final event will be held on **May 14th from 7:00-8:30PM.**

Confirmation Sponsor Info

*Candidates **MUST** have a Confirmation Sponsor who meets the following criteria:*

Who can be a sponsor?

- An active Catholic (at least 16 years of age) who is free to receive the Sacraments.
- Someone who has celebrated Confirmation in the Catholic Church.
- Someone who has and will have an ongoing relationship with the candidate.
- Someone able to be present at Confirmation.
- **NOT A PARENT** (Godparent, sibling, extended family, family friend, and parent of friend are all permissible).

Ideally this adult would also:

- Attend each of the Confirmation Reflection Days/Evenings with the student.
- Discuss faith and offer prayerful support during preparation and beyond.
- Pray with and for the student.
- *If the sponsor is locally unavailable (lives out of state, sibling who attends school out of town etc...) a parent can attend the formation events in their place, while the sponsor fulfills the other commitments.*

Preparing with the Parish

Parish Connection

1. Attend Sunday Liturgy each week
2. Complete 2 *Parish Involvement Projects*. One each in:
 - Service
 - Learning
3. Complete an "At Home" journal
 - Weekly assignments January to April.
 - Includes Gospel reflections, written responses to parish involvement, sponsor/candidate reflections, as well as other materials.
4. Attend a Catholic Retreat:
 - 1 of 4 offered through the parish or
 - Catholic High School Retreat or
 - NET or other *approved* Catholic Retreat.
5. Attend Parish Rite of Welcome at Masses on Sunday, January 22 and the sending forth to Confirmation at Masses on Sunday, May 13.
6. Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation at Parish's Lenten Reconciliation Service. (Tuesday March 13)
7. Provide a copy of candidate's Baptismal Certificate if they were baptized some place other than All Saints. (*even if 1st Eucharist was here*)
8. Complete a 30-minute interview with a parish representative to articulate your desire to be confirmed. (April.)

Classroom Connection

1. Attending Grade 10 FEP
 - *Students are expected to attend all scheduled classes. Significant absences could affect eligibility for Confirmation.*
 - *It is not always possible for students to substitute one session for another. Students should expect to attend on their scheduled days.*

OR

2. Attend an accredited Catholic High School & taking Grade 10 or higher religion classes **AND** participate in *Foundations* monthly.

OR

3. Active participation in an *approved* Catholic Home School Association (full time home-schooling) **AND** participate in *Foundations* monthly.

Confirmation Names

Candidates may either choose to keep their Baptismal name or choose a different Confirmation name. When choosing a different name it **must** meet the following criteria:

- A Saint's name or derivative of a Saint's name (St. Dennis = Denise) or
- Person in Scripture who had a relationship with God (Abraham)
- One name, not a combination of names.

2011-12 Confirmation Retreats Options:

Candidates for Confirmation are asked to participate in a Catholic retreat. This can be either a daytime or overnight experience. Students must register in advance for these retreats. Program Policy & Guidelines

Class Attendance:

- ✚ Students are expected to attend each scheduled class. They are expected to be on time and prepared.
 - ✚ Some sessions are required for Confirmation and should not be missed.
 - ✚ Students are excused for illness and family emergency once during the year. Students are excused for school related requirements (band concert, choir concert) once during the year. In either case the Program Director should be contacted via e-mail (mswanson@allsaintschurch.com).
 - ✚ Students will be expected to complete homework assignments if they miss more than two classes. If they miss more than three sessions they may be asked to postpone preparation until another time.
 - ✚ If student has extenuating circumstances (ex: long-term health issue) the family should contact Michaelleen Swanson, Coordinator of Senior High Faith Formation to consider options.

Class Scheduling & Cancellations:

Generally All Saints follows the Lakeville School District calendar. There are some exceptions.

Weather cancellations:

- ✚ If Lakeville schools (ISD #194) have a weather cancellation or early dismissal, FEP classes will not meet.
- ✚ If classes need to be canceled because of inclement weather, we will make every reasonable attempt to notify families.
 - WCCO (AM 830) will announce our cancellations
 - You may also check the web: allsaintschurch.com
 - An e-mail will be sent to the household.
- ✚ Please use your best judgment when the weather is questionable.

Cancellations due to Widespread Illness:

- ✚ If classes need to be canceled because of widespread illness, families will be notified through phone call and/or e-mail.
 - ✚ Information regarding program accommodations and adjusted schedules will be posted on the web at www.allsaintschurch.com.
 - ✚ Please keep students who are ill at home.

Guidelines for Student Drivers:

- ✚ Students 16 and older with a valid driver's license are able to drive to class with parent permission.
 - ✚ This right can and will be revoked by the Program Director if:
 - Student driver is caught driving recklessly on parish grounds.
 - Student driver (or passengers) is disrespectful to other students or parishioners while behind the wheel.
 - Student driver fails to provide for the safety of his/her passengers (no cell phone, everyone seat belted).
 - ✚ Student drivers should park near the "Bell Tower" doors, near the Commons.

Cell Phone/Media Policy:

- ✚ From the beginning of class time until dismissal, students are expected to have cell phones and other media devices (including ear buds) off and out of site.
- ✚ Students are expected not to answer calls or read text messages while classes are in session.
- ✚ If a student is found to be using these devices during class:
 - First Offense: The device will be confiscated and returned at the end of class.
 - Second Offense: The device will be confiscated and given to the Program Director. A parent will need to make arrangements to pick up the device from the Director.
