

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING TO SCHOOL FOR MY CHILD?

Please make sure your child has a backpack or bag in which to carry home any projects or papers. The backpack should be large enough to hold winter outerwear. Place your last name somewhere on the backpack.

NOTE: When purchasing winter gear, have your child try them on in the store to see if they are able to pull on the boots, gloves, snowpants, etc. It is very frustrating for them to be unable to do these tasks on their own due to the style or small size purchased. Finger gloves are very difficult for small children, as are jackets and boots with liners. Make sure snowpants are large enough to be pulled over their pants. Then label everything with your last name.

Also, we are asking each class to help us out by bringing a few supplies that will be shared by all classes. These supplies can be brought either to the Open House or on the Parent/Child Activity Day. There will be boxes provided to place the items. There is no need to label any items as they will be shared by all classes. Food items are for making play doh and other crafts and will not be consumed.
